What is the SHIN-NY?

The SHIN-NY is a statewide network that facilitates **secure and confidential sharing of patient data** across the healthcare system to improve outcomes.

The SHIN-NY is comprised of 8 Qualified Entities (QEs) that are regional health information exchanges.

Participating healthcare professionals can seamlessly exchange health information, with patient consent, to increase collaboration, better coordinate care, and lower costs.

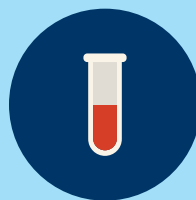

Bottom Line: Patient Records, Sharable Statewide

SHIN-NY participants have access to their consented patients' health information, helping to identify life-threatening allergies or critical medication interactions, avoid unnecessary and duplicative tests, and share treatment plans across care teams to better coordinate care. Through the SHIN-NY, participants can also sign up to receive real-time alerts when their patients end up in the ER or are admitted to the hospital.
